Yokogawa Middle East & Africa

Challenges

Yokogawa Middle East & Africa had a traditional on-premises file server set-up, and they were also using a hybrid file-share service. However, their storage budget kept increasing exponentially. They also found it hard to predict cloud charges, adding to mounting costs and complexity.

Solution

Tiger Bridge data management software enabled the Yokogawa team to switch from their existing costly and complex solution to a straightforward, reliable and cost-effective hybrid cloud architecture with AWS. Tiger Bridge successfully migrated data from over 35 servers without requiring any additional high-performance hardware.

Results

Yokogawa Middle East & Africa achieved a 60% reduction in storage costs with Tiger Bridge, leveraging cloud archive tiers in a hybrid environment. At first, Tiger Bridge was used to enable immediate burst for capacity, and at a second stage, global file access functionality was added to enable geographically dispersed offices to collaborate on the same data set. In addition, cloud charges are now easy to predict, and the Yokogawa team have not had to modify their existing infrastructure or budget for any “hidden” costs throughout the process.

- Preserves all metadata – the smart stub file technology by Tiger creates zero-byte files locally that contain all metadata and point to the files’ location in Amazon S3
